



Save Water - Save A Buck program guidelines for Landscape Contractors

Following are guidelines for Landscape Contractors wishing to participate in receiving rebates for the installation of water efficient devices. This program is for Commercial Properties and Multi-Family Properties with more than 5 units only and does not apply to single-family residential properties.

Eligible Rebates and Devices:

Weather Based “Smart” Irrigation Controllers (WBIC) and
Central Computer Irrigation Controller (CCIC) Systems - \$25 per station capacity

Rotating Nozzles for Pop-Up Spray Heads - \$4 or more per nozzle
(25 unit minimum - no maximum)

High Efficiency Nozzles for Large Rotary Sprinklers - \$13 or more per set
(8 set minimum - no maximum)

Synthetic Turf - 30¢ or more per square foot

Guidelines:

1. Contractor must possess a valid C-27 Landscape Contractor License or a D-12 Synthetic Turf Contractor License issued by the California Contractors State License Board.
2. Contractor must provide an original purchase invoice. A copy of the invoice is acceptable if purchase is done in bulk for multiple jobs.
3. Contractor must present a copy of customer job order (contract/agreement) with contractor. Job order must be signed by customer and include a bill of materials (includes product ID and quantity).
4. Contractor must present verification of installation with the rebate application, including:
 - a. Customer’s signature verifying products that have been installed (manufacturer, model, quantity) and have been programmed and/or adjusted
 - b. Receipts of product purchased
 - c. Installation and labor
 - d. Copy of contractor’s C-27 or D-12 license number
5. Contractor must present all applicable data required for other devices, including but not limited to: customer water bill number, address where the installation took place, and name of owner or contact for inspection and verification by Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.
