This base rebate information sheet is only applicable for Commercial, Industrial and Institutional customers of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (MWD). Base rebates are funded by MWD and limited to the actual cost of the device, and may not exceed the maximum rebate per device listed on this rebate sheet. Unless specifically noted, actual device costs **exclude** tax, shipping, labor, and other charges.

Local water agencies' additional rebates, if available in your area, may vary from actual costs to a flat amount depending on the device, therefore the estimated rebate listed on the website agency pages is the maximum amount possible. Your actual rebate may vary depending on the actual cost of the device purchased.

Connectionless Food Steamer	<i>Food Steamers without a water line.</i>	\$ 485	Per Compartment	YES
Ice-Making Machine	<i>Applies to installation of new air-cooled ice machines.</i>	\$ 300	Each	YES
Dry Vacuum Pump	<i>Maximum 2 Horsepower (HP) motor.</i>	\$ 125	Per 0.5 HP	NO
Cooling Tower Conductivity Controller (CTCC)	<i>Automatically maintains conductivity or TDS level.</i>	\$ 625	Each	NO
Cooling Tower pH Controller (pH-CTC)	<i>Automatically maintains pH levels of re-circulated water.</i>	\$ 1,750	Each	NO
Weather-Based Irrigation Controller (WBIC)	<i>Upgrades to existing equipment that enable functionality as a WBIC may qualify for incentives provided they meet program terms and conditions.</i>	\$ 25	Station	YES - IA SWAT Approved
